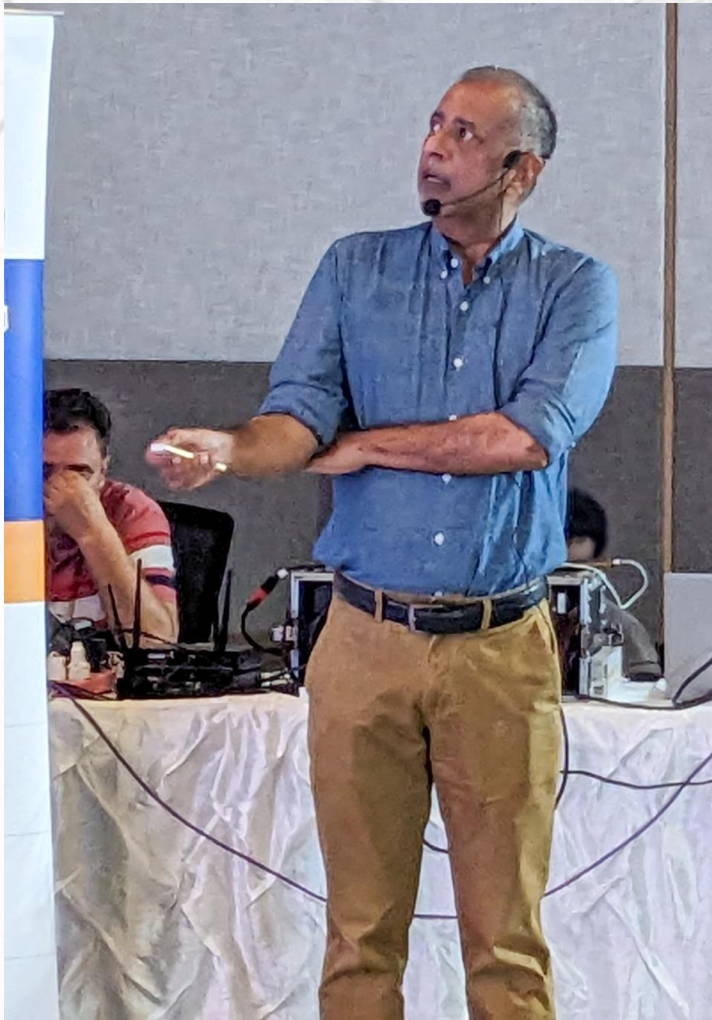

Faruqi did his B.Arch from DCET Karachi, Pakistan and M.Arch from IIT Chicago, U.S.A. He has been teaching at IVSAA, Karachi, since 1992. In 2006 he established his Design House under the banner of 'Copper and Steel' where he practices Architecture, Interior Design and Landscape Design. He has been reviving the crafts of copper and works with local craftsmen and incorporates it in his tableware, fountains and furniture designs. He is the Founder member of Pakistan Crafts Council, Pursukoon Karachi and Black Olive Publication. He served as the Chairman Institute of Architects (IAP) Karachi Chapter and as Chairman-Board of Architectural Education for the National Council of IAP. Faruqi has won IAP Design Excellence award as well as ADA Award along with several Honorable Mentions and recently been awarded Fellowship of the Institute of Architects Pakistan. His Installation 'Crossing the Border' is part of the National History Museum, Lahore, Pakistan. 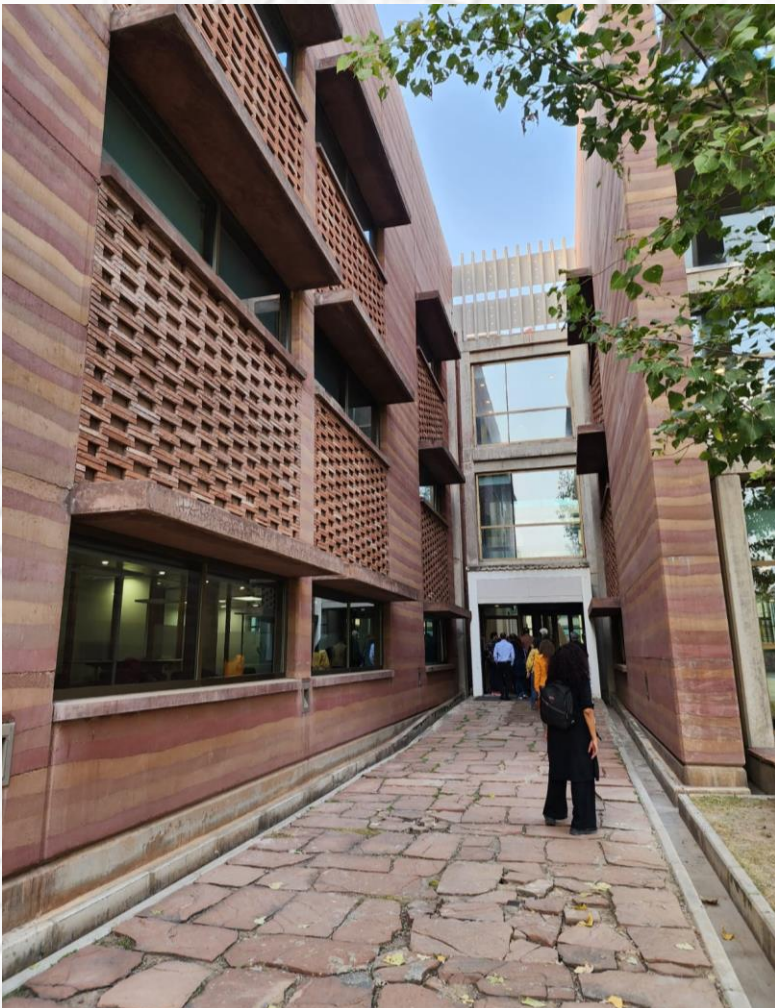
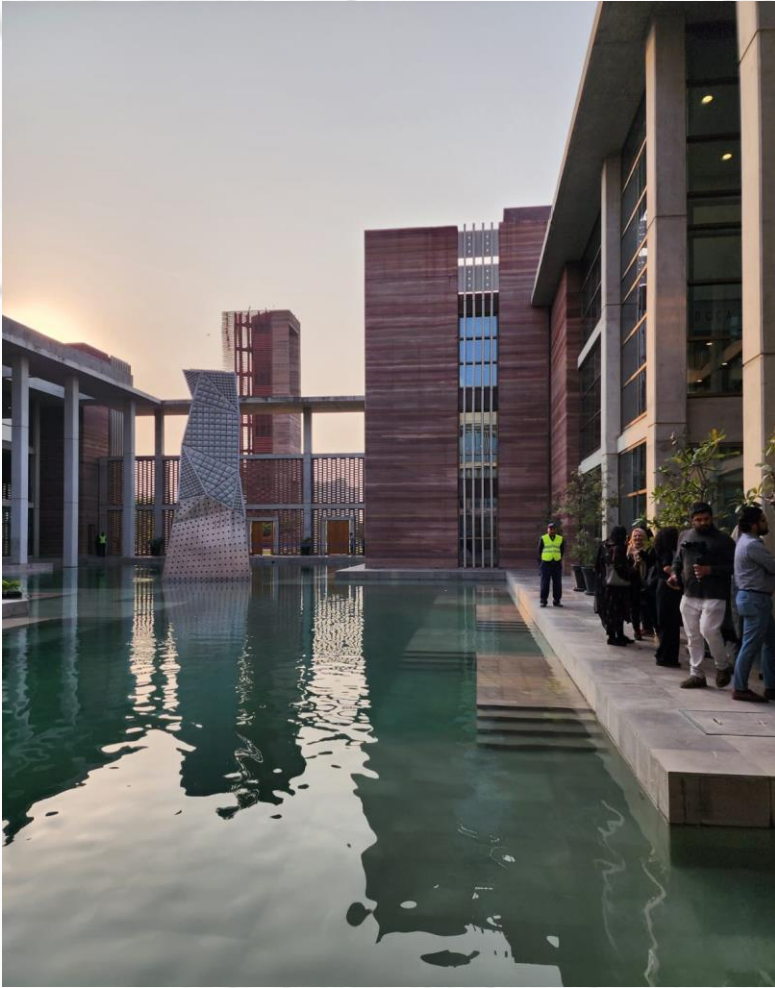

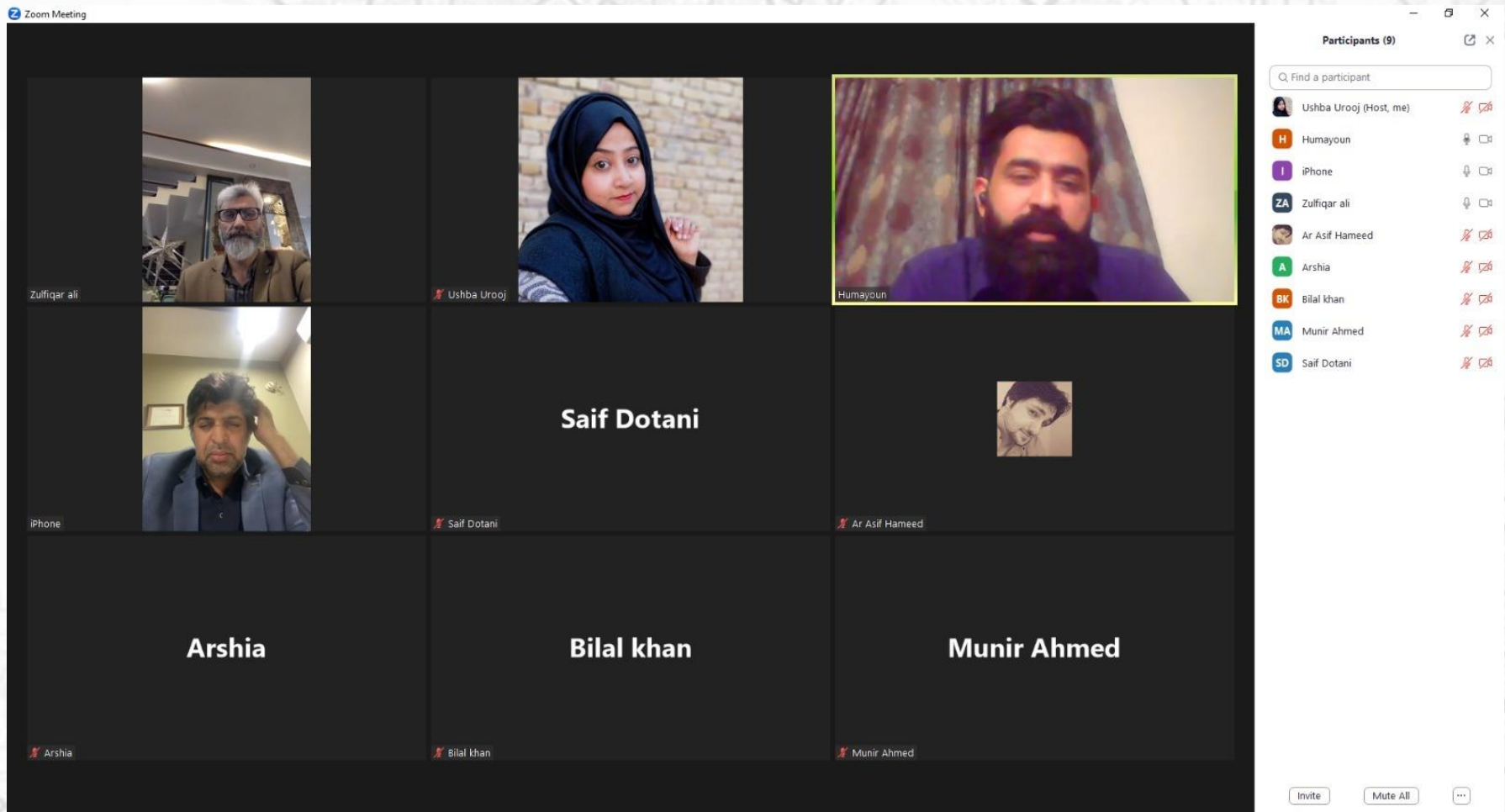

DESIGN CONCEPT

SUSTAINABLE FUTURES

An Innovative and sustainable Pavilion that upcycles and improves footprint rather than reducing footprint.

COMPETITION OVERVIEW:

In a typical sustainable environment, citizens are encouraged to reduce, reuse and recycle. In this reductionist approach to living, the least lived would be most sustainable. This competition is designed to redefine the concept of conventional sustainability by encouraging to live life, not reducing it. Therefore, we are encouraging prospective candidates to improve footprint and celebrate life in the process of their design; rather than reducing it.

Candidates are requested to create an architecture that can be renewable or reusable or both; thus improving its sustainability footprint in the process. Ideally, to serve a new purpose after the event would carry extra credit.

SITE CONTEXT:

Pakistan-China Friendship Centre is an art, conference, and exhibition center in Islamabad, Pakistan. It is developed with the help of China-Pakistan relations and was gifted by China to Pakistan. The center is built on 12 acres of land having 1000 plus parking spaces available. It is a unique venue among all the government-owned venues having a state of the art architecture. The pavilion site is located in the forecourt within the premises of the PCF Centre.

SITE CONSTRAINTS:

- The following are the constraints of the site.
1. The Structure should be resilient to heavy rainfall and high-speed wind
 2. Site is available for 2 days ahead of the event. Execution of the pavilion should be targeted for completion in the given timeframe.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- The Competition is open to all Affiliate / Associate and Fellow Members.
- A maximum group of 5 Affiliate/Associate/Fellow members can participate as a team.
- Names of all team members to be shared at the time of registration.
- All Non-members Architects can collectively participate by applying for IAP membership and competition registration.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Entry requirements are as follows.

1. 3 No. A1 Sheets
 - a. Title sheet with concept
 - b. Plans, Section, Elevation & schematic diagrams.
 - c. 3d Images
2. A white rectangle of 4"x4" be marked on the lower left side on all sheets. Filled with contestant reg no
3. Soft copy of all sheets.
4. A-4 write-up. Describe your concept, Idea and special feature using illustration, 3d images, Plans,
5. Section Elevation and Schematic Diagrams

JUDGING CRITERIA:

The submission will be judged on but not limited to the following:

- a) Sustainability Criteria as defined in overview,
- b) Workability of the overall idea/design for potential implementation,
- c) Functionality of the project,
- d) External Facade design proposal,
- e) Presentation skills

Top 6 designs selected will be execute their respective pavilions.

PRIZES AND AWARDS:

- 1st Prize = PKR 100,000
- 2nd Prize = PKR 75,000
- 3rd Prize = PKR 50,000
- 3 x Honorable Mentions - PKR 25,000 each
