

President of the Institute of Architects Pakistan, Ar. Fawad Suhail Abbasi was invited as a panelist at the National Energy Efficiency & Conservation Authority (NEECA) dialogue session titled "Conversation Conversations" on "Smarter Cooling, Heating & Energy Control in Pakistan's Buildings."

The event was held on October 9, 2025, at the National Incubation Centre(NIC), Islamabad, and focused on the recently introduced Energy Conservation Building Code (ECBC 2023). #### 16th Oct IAP+NEECA TO WORK JOINTLY ON THE ECBC CITIZENS GUIDE

In a significant step towards mainstreaming energy efficiency in Pakistan's built environment, the Institute of Architects Pakistan (IAP) hosted a collaborative meeting with the National Energy Efficiency & Conservation Authority (NEECA) on October 16, 2025, at the IAP Secretariat in Islamabad. The meeting, attended by key figures from both organizations, served as a direct follow-up to last week's Conservation Conversation, focusing on the practical implementation of the Energy Conservation Building Code (ECBC).

The IAP delegation was led by President Ar. Fawad Suhail Abbasi, and included Vice President Ar. Dr. Samra Mohsin Khan, Past President IAP Ar. Jahangir Khan Sherpao, Past Vice Chairperson IAP-RIC Ar. Shazia Qureshi, IAP Green Initiative Lead Ar. Haadiya Abbas, and COO IAP Mr. Farhan Siddiqui. They were joined by NEECA's team, comprising Director of Awareness & Outreach Ms. Mahwish Khan, and Assistant Directors Mr. Bilal Ali and Mr. Fahad Rashid. The core consensus of the discussion was that while the ECBC provides an essential technical backbone, a critical communication gap prevents its widespread adoption. To bridge this gap, IAP and NEECA have agreed to jointly develop a "Citizen's Guide to Energy-Efficient Buildings." This initiative aims to translate the Code's technicalities into a practical, understandable narrative for homeowners, developers, and young architects, clearly illustrating the "why" and "how" of energy-smart construction in cost-saving terms.

The long-term goal is to build organic demand for efficient buildings, steering Pakistan towards sustainable urban growth through informed choice rather than regulatory enforcement alone. To further this mission, both organizations have planned a joint roundtable to raise awareness about the ECBC among practicing architects and architecture students, while also emphasizing the need to onboard key stakeholders like CDA, PEC, PCATP, and the HVACR Society to ensure a cohesive and effective implementation strategy nationwide. The efforts are to start this from the Federal Capital and take them to provincial authorities in phase two.





#### 23rd Oct Execution Plan for "Echoes of Rawalpindi

## RDA and IAP-RIC Collaborate on Execution Plan for "Echoes of Rawalpindi – Urban Monument Design Challenge"

A coordination meeting was held at the Rawalpindi Development Authority (RDA) office between RDA officials and representatives of the Institute of Architects Pakistan – Rawalpindi Islamabad Chapter (IAP-RIC) to discuss the execution plan for the selected monument designs under the "Echoes of Rawalpindi – Urban Monument Design Challenge."

The meeting focused on the proposed installations at JCP-6 (Koral Chowk) and JCP-4 (Chorr Chowk) sites.

The meeting was chaired by Dr. Mansoor Khan, Additional Director General, RDA, along with Mr. Jawad Arshad (Deputy Director Engineering), Ms. Rukhsar Amaima (Assistant Director Engineering), and Mr. Naeem Hashim (Sub Engineer, RDA).

The IAP-RIC delegation included Ar. Rweeda Himayat (Chairperson IAP-RIC), Ar. Rana Atif Rehman (Convener, Echoes of Rawalpindi), and Ar. Bushra Khan (Co-Convener, Echoes of Rawalpindi).

Chairperson Ar. Rweeda Himayat presented an overview of the Echoes of Rawalpindi competition and acknowledged immediate past Chairman RIC Ar. Abdullah Khan and RDA Ar. Rida Sultan's contributions in the initiation of the conceptual and developmental stages of the competition.

She reaffirmed IAP-RIC's continued support to RDA through professional facilitation, design supervision, and technical assistance during the execution phase.

RDA informed that the design selected for the "Chorr Chowk monument was chosen based on feasibility, contextual relevance, and sustainability.

It was mutually agreed that RDA retains the authority to finalize any shortlisted design—whether among the top three or otherwise—based on executability and long-term viability.

In response to RDA's queries, \*Ar. Rana Atif explained the jury's evaluation criteria, emphasizing considerations such as conceptual strength, material durability, and cost feasibility.

The competition guidelines had specified that the estimated cost per monument should not exceed a specific amount, ensuring practical and sustainable implementation.

Dr. Mansoor Khan directed that once RDA finalizes the selected designs, the respective architects will be contacted formally to submit their presentations, BOQs, and cost proposals by November 4, 2025. He also encouraged IAP-RIC to help identify and align specialized contractors experienced in architectural monument execution.

Ar. Bushra Khan highlighted the need for each designer to present complete execution details, including BOQs, material costs, and contractor expertise.

The next coordination meeting is scheduled for November 4, 2025, which will be led by the Convener and Co-Convener of the initiative.

The meeting concluded with appreciation extended to , Dr. Mansoor Khan, Additional Director General, RDA, for his guidance and continued support toward realizing this collaborative initiative that celebrates Rawalpindi's urban identity through architecture and design.
